



We are seeking Coaches and Coaching Assistants for our after school sports clubs and teams.

While our immediate need is for Hockey and Netball we will welcome applicants with other interests and skill sets. Athletic competence, a passion for working with young people, reliability and a willingness to work as part of a small team are equally important.

After school sessions take place Monday to Thursday 4.30pm to 5.30pm and school hockey fixtures are scheduled every Saturday morning to the start of summer term. There may be occasional midweek fixtures.

## Main Responsibilities

- To support PE staff in the delivery of high quality games and coaching sessions.
- To deliver and lead on session content when required.
- To promote the welfare of children at all times. Helping to create an enjoyable experience for all participants.
- To support competitive weekend and midweek sports fixtures, by coaching, officiating, controlling pitch side and completing pre and post match set up and tidy up activities.
- Provide basic first aid and medical treatment and recognise when specialist treatment is required.
- To match the ethos and expectations of Wellington School in everything that you do.

## Skills and Attributes Required

- Evidence of a competitive sporting background, demonstrating a range of physical skills and competences.
- Evidence of an interest in working with young people and within sport.
- Ability to communicate tactical concepts and demonstrate techniques in a clear, enthusiastic and appropriate manner.
- Reliability and a helpful approach to work.
- Evidence of ability to commit to a regular working schedule built around school term times.
- Successful candidates will be required to become a PVG Scheme member, or undergo a PVG Scheme update if they are already a member. The cost for this shall be borne by the school.
